Pfizer Injectables is committed to ensuring high quality products for healthcare providers and their patients. As such, we would like to provide you with an update on National Drug Code (NDC) labeling of our products. We are continuing to implement changes to the way the NDC numbers are displayed on our injectable products to address evolving expectations.

Unit of Use NDC Updates

New **Unit of Use NDC** numbers have been assigned to **23** products since the last update in November 2018. This change is to the last two digits of the NDC, known as the package code, at the **Unit of Use** level. This is done to distinguish between the **Unit of Sale** and the **Unit of Use** in the event they are different quantities. The product NDC is left unchanged and is also included in the product insert. The product NDC will continue to be the **Unit of Sale** and is the NDC that should be used when ordering product. The **Unit of Use NDC** should be utilized for bedside scanning.

Inner Pack NDC Updates

Two (2) new **Inner Pack NDC** numbers have been assigned for products since November 2018. These new **Inner Pack NDC** numbers will appear only on non-saleable inner packs and will be used to distinguish an inner pack from both the **Unit of Sale** and **Unit of Use**.

For ease of reference, a complete listing of impacted products is provided as an appendix to this letter. Please note that this list only indicates the addition of a **Unit of Use NDC** and/or **Inner Pack NDC** numbers and is not an indication of available supply. As part of this ongoing transition, you may continue to receive product without the new **Unit of Use** and/or **Inner Pack NDC** numbers.
